SIN EJÉRCITO DESDE 1948

Costa Rica abolió su ejército en 1948, lo que lo convierte en uno de los pocos países en el mundo sin fuerzas armadas permanentes. Desde entonces, el país ha dedicado recursos a la educación, la salud y la conservación ambiental.

BIODIVERSIDAD EXTRAORDINARIA:

Aunque Costa Rica ocupa solo el 0.03% de la superficie terrestre mundial, alberga alrededor del 5% de la biodiversidad del planeta. El país es un líder en conservación, con más de una cuarta parte de su territorio protegido en parques nacionales y reservas.

“PURA VIDA”

“Pura Vida” es una frase común en Costa Rica que se traduce literalmente como “vida pura”. Sin embargo, para los costarricenses, esta expresión representa una filosofía de vida, que refleja su enfoque positivo, tranquilo y agradecido hacia la vida. Se utiliza para saludar, despedirse o expresar que todo está bien.







Families will provide three meals per day, as well as laundry service weekly over the duration of the program.





Our curriculum leverages Costa Rica's rich cultural and historical backdrop through educational excursions to various significant sites.





LA FORTUNA


- Visit **Arenal Volcano** and its national park
