HOUSING



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Open to all majors Minimum 2.5 GPA Must be in good standing
- Beginner Track: No previous Spanish Language experience required
- Intermediate Track: Prerequisities of SPN 2201 and/or SPN 2240,
 or AP, IB, SAT II scores equivalent
 *Note: Bilingual students not eligible.

PRICING

2024 Undergraduate Program Fee: \$7,120

A \$395 nonrefundable deposit toward the total cost of the program is due at the time of application. The remaining fees are due no later than 45 days prior to departure. If you receive financial aid, you can defer payment until it disburses. Deferment decisions will be based on the amount of aid to be received.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

Tuition, housing, three meals a day, cultural and overnight excursions, daily tutoring, computer access at the UIMP computer lab, and MEDEX emergency assistance coverage.

WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED

Round-trip airfare, and additional personal travel and expenses.

FINANCIAL AID

Most financial aid that you would receive on campus can be applied toward the cost of this program. However, all financial aid eligibility is determined by Student Financial Aid & Scholarships.
